Day 1: WELCOME to Ivato Airport – Transfer to the hotel

ANTANANARIVO

You will visit the former Rova Royal Palace of Madagascar. This is one of the famous historical cultures of Madagascar during the colonial period, established by the monarchs of the Kingdom of Imerina in the 17th and 18th. It is located at an altitude of 1462 m on the highest point of the capital, the Analamanga, which is almost 200 m over the quarters of the lower town.







Day 2: Nosy Be

After breakfast we will take a plane to Nosy Be and when we get there we can relax and enjoy the warm sea and soft beach of Nosy Be.

NOSY BE

Nosy Be Madagascar's number one beach destination. Nosy Be Island has all the ingredients you would expect: soft white sand, turquoise waters and wonderful seafood.

With its sunny climate for most of the year, it is a haven for aquatic activities. Diving is the main attraction, and there are plenty of opportunities for swimming, snorkeling, sailing, and fishing. The organizers offer excursions to the surrounding islands with their beautiful beaches and great diving opportunities.

When you've had enough of seascapes, head to the hilly landscapes of the little-explored hinterland: In addition to the brilliant Parc National Lokobe, there are ylang-ylang and vanilla plantations, crater lakes and waterfalls, as well as miles of miles that can only be reached on foot or by quad bike Dirt roads.

Day 3: Nosy Tanikely

Today is the day of diving. After breakfast, a boat trip to Nosy Tanikely begins. Discover the diverse nature and the animals under water. A diving mask can be used for diving. Under the sea there is an aquarium where you can admire a magnificent display of corals and anemones, myriads of colorful fish, mussels, perch, moray eels and sea turtles. To discover, it is also possible to swim and the beach invites you to lie down.

In the evening you will spend the night at the Hotel Palm Beach Resort, a 4-star hotel.



NOSY TANIKELY

Nosy Tanikely means "island of the small earth", which alludes to the small area of the island. But there is a lot more to see underwater: The colorful, still completely intact coral gardens reach a few meters from the beach and are home to an incredible wealth of fish, starfish, sea urchins, sea cucumbers and other marine life.

Puffer fish and groupers find a home among giant surgeon fish. Whole schools of fish move past you, dazzlingly colorful, and with the underwater camera you sometimes don't even know where to take the photo first.

Day 4: Nosy Komba

The day before was dedicated to the visit to the marine reserve and today to the discovery of the nature reserve of Nosy Komba. There can be lemurs and small birds to watch. Of course, you can enjoy the beautiful green nature of the park. Don't forget to bring your swimming gear, as you will be swimming again after visiting the park. Overnight at the Hotel Palm Beach Resort, 4-star hotel.

NOSY KOMBA

It is quiet as there are no cars or electricity. The beauty of nature and the sweetness of life make it an extremely attractive place.

Nosy Komba is known for its many small and inhabited beaches and for its emerald-like water. Nosy komba is a little gem of nature that is increasingly visited and becomes a mirror of its larger neighbor Nosy Be.

It is home to many makis, a variety of lemurs also called macaco.







Day 5: Visit of the Passot Mountain

After breakfast we will visit Mount Passot, also known as Bongo Pisa in Madagascar, which is a volcanic hill in the middle of the island of Nosy Be in Madagascar.

Day 6: Nosy Lokobe

Today you will discover the nature reserve of Nosy Lokobe. There are medicinal plants and various tropical and rainforests to visit, as well as fauna and flora. You will stay at Hotel Palm Beach Resort, 4 star hotel.

NOSY IRANJA
